



Lei Care



Purple Orchid Lei

Lightly mist with a spray bottle or flick drops of water from your fingers onto the lei, then place the lei in a plastic grocery bag. Seal the bag and place it in the door of your refrigerator until graduation day. Please do not "drench" the lei, just a light misting will help it rehydrate.

Tinted Leis

Do NOT mist. Rather, place the lei in a plastic grocery bag and seal it. Place the bag in the door of your refrigerator until graduation day. The leis are misted before they are shipped. If the tinted leis get too wet at home and do not dry before commencement, then there is a possibility of the color bleeding onto the gowns. Therefore please do not mist, just place in the bag and put in the refrigerator.

Ti Leaf Lei

Gently coil the lei and wrap it in newspaper or a paper towel, then store it in the door of your refrigerator. Before wearing, we recommend to air dry the lei at room temperature for at least one hour. This helps prevent the leaves' natural oils from staining the gowns. The ti leaf needs to be completely dry before use—any remaining moisture may stain a light-colored gown. If needed, you may use a clean, dry paper towel to gently blot away moisture. If there is noticeable oil residue (which is natural), you may gently rinse it in clean water, dry thoroughly, and repeat if necessary.
